The Program



The camp is an eight-day program with two days dedicated to each of the three emergency services. The first day is a fun day to get to know each other. The last day is when you demonstrate your new skills and the importance of teamwork amongst the emergency service responders to get the job done.



How to Apply For Camp Courage

The camp is 100% free.

The selection process includes filling out the application containing a short answer question describing how you can improve someone else's life, or your community, and submitting two letters of recommendation. Instead of paying tuition, you do what you described. The only limitation is your imagination.
