Managing complex situations

Sometimes students and families are already connected to many services, but still need help managing it all. We can help make sure everyone involved is communicating clearly so that we can offer the best support possible.



School referrals: Principals, Vice Principals, or School Counsellors can submit referrals directly after discussing SchoolsPlus with a student or family.

Community referrals: Staff from various organizations in the community (such as the IWK, Community Services, family centres, etc.) can make referrals by contacting the Assistant Leader.

Self referrals: Students and families can refer themselves by contacting the Assistant Leader.
